

복문에서 주절의 주어와 종속절의 주어가 동일 할 때 명사와 대명사의 위치

If the subject of a main clause and that of a subordinate are the same person or the same thing, where should the "noun" and "pronoun" be located?

- 1) Is the first subject (object) "noun" and the next one "pronoun"?
- 2) Should "noun" be used in the main clause and "pronoun" in the subordinate clause?

Examples:

In the following sentences, "John" and "he" are the same man.

False or True

John met Alice when he was taking a walk. (0)

When John was taking a walk, he met Alice. ( )

When he was taking a walk, John met Alice. ( )

"He" and "John" are different persons? ( )

Participle constructions

John met Alice (when he was) taking a walk. ( )

(When he was) Taking (taking) a walk, John met Alice. ( )
